

## Kenosha Velodrome Operational Rules 2010 season

- 1) The Kenosha Velodrome is permitted by the American Track Racing Association (ATRA). A completed Liability and Medical release from must be filed with registration. One form is required for the season.
- 2) The minimum prize list is \$475 per official race night. Additional prizes may be added for special events. No payouts on pre-season races held May 18 and May 25.
- 3) The Kenosha Velodrome has adopted the FIAC/ABR rules for the events. The velodrome will also enforce gear restrictions races within the following categories:
  - 15-16: 6.78 meters (22'3")
  - 13-14: 6.36 meters (20'10.5")
  - 10-12: 6.00 meters (19'8")Selection, interpretation, and enforcement of these rules are the sole responsibility of the Chief Referee.
- 4) Registration opens at 6 pm and closes at 6:55. Races begin promptly at 7 pm.
- 5) Entry fees are \$10 for juniors, \$20 for Seniors. Juniors racing Senior events pay \$20 and Seniors racing Masters events pay \$25.
- 6) Race entry fees may be refunded for rained out events. At the promoter's option, refunds may be whole or in part, in cash or credited to a future event.
- 7) A race number fee of \$5 will be charged for each permanent number assigned. Numbers are used for the full race season. Permanent numbers from the 2009 season may be used for the 2010 race season.
- 8) Numbers are to be placed on the left side in plain view of the officials. Failure to properly display your race number may result in disqualification.
- 9) Race categories are determined by licenses held by other organizations (USA Cycling, ABR). New riders will be placed in category 5. Changes from the categories are at the Rider Upgrade Committee's discretion.
- 10) Racers may compete in as many events as eligible. Cat 4-5 Masters may not ride 30+, but may ride, 40+, if eligible..
- 11) Races are subject to change without prior notice. Classes or events may be added, split, combined, changed or cancelled at the promoter's discretion.
- 12) The Main event is open to Cat 1-3 riders only.
- 13) The Consolation race is open to Cat 4-5 riders only.
- 14) Selection, interpretation, and enforcement of these guidelines are at the discretion of the Race Director or his/her designee.
